Regional Director

The Governor's Office of Economic Development (GOED) is currently seeking a mission-driven, strategic-focused, and business-minded Regional Director to oversee the internal operations of this statewide agency and to provide leadership for economic development efforts throughout northern and rural Nevada. Through strong internal and external communication, problem solving, capacity building, legislative awareness, and financial leveraging, the Regional Director will work to solidify partnerships and strong regional collaboration.

With primary responsibility for the GOED's budget, human resources, and other administrative functions, the Regional Director oversees the office's compliance with statutes and regulations and will serve as a thought partner with GOED's Executive Director around operational efficiencies and business opportunities. Reporting directly to the Executive Director, the Regional Director serves as a key member of the senior leadership team of the office and will work closely with the Deputy Director in the deployment of GOED's various economic development programs.

Widely knowledgeable about Nevada, the Regional Director also functions as the direct link between GOED and the individual Regional Development Authorities (RDAs) throughout northern and rural Nevada. The Regional Director prepares Requests for Proposals and contracts, analyzes applications, and monitors RDA performance. The Regional Director assists RDAs with planning efforts, developing sensible performance assessment criteria, and business attraction, expansion, and retention.

The location for this position is in Carson City. A Regional Director must have a degree from an accredited post-secondary institution with relevant managerial experience.

The annual salary range for the Regional Director is \$95,000 - \$110,000 and reflects retirement contributions by both the employee and the employer. An employer-paid contribution plan is also available at a reduced gross salary. The salary range listed does not reflect the deduction of required furlough (approximately 2.3%) pursuant to *Nevada Administrative Code* 284.531. The State of Nevada offers an excellent benefit package.
